- ! The voting dates have been set as follows:
  - Wednesday November 6, 2019 from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm**
  - Thursday November 7, 2019 from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm**
- ! **Voting will be held at the Granum Drop In Centre 306 Railway Avenue**
  
- ! A person is eligible to vote if the person
  - a) Is at least 18 years old
  - b) Is a Canadian citizen
  - c) Resides in Alberta and the person's place of residence on voting day is the town of Granum
  
- ! Voter identification showing residency will be required.
  
- ! Special ballots (mail-in) are available for electors who have physical disability or will be away from the town during the days of the vote.
